But there is often scant difference. The Downsides of Using Older Editions of Textbooks Include any edition information in parentheses after the title, without italics. If the book includes a DOI, include the DOI in the reference after the publisher name. Do not include the publisher location. If the book does not have a DOI and is an ebook from an academic research database, end the book reference after the publisher name. Book References - APA Style The main difference between the U.S. version and the international version of a textbook is the cover. Many U.S. textbooks have a hard cover, known as casebound, while the international version has a soft cover. In some cases, the images on the cover may differ slightly while others will have the same cover image and design on a paperback book. The Differences Between U.S. and International Textbooks ...
