AD 480–550) for monks living communally under the authority of an abbot. An 8th-century copy of the Rule of Saint Benedict. The spirit of Saint Benedict's Rule is summed up in the motto of the Benedictine Confederation: pax ("peace") and the traditional ora et labora ("pray and work").
